The topics were:

Moths in wool rugs and clothing, Identification fall weeds (sowthistle, groundsel, Florida wild lettuce and ragweed), fall tent caterpillars and bag worms, fungal leaf spots on Helianthus simulans; plant ID (Ironweed); diseased China Girl Holly; plant ID (possible bayberry or saltbush); ID cause of diseased rosemary bush, large assumed healthy oak which fell, apparently diseased, soil samples, fire blight, small flying insects in the house, when is the best time to plant trees, 120 boxwoods that appear to be in decline.
